

Summer 2025 POST RESULT EXAMINATION SERVICES



Exam boards take their responsibility to ensure results are accurate very seriously, with quality assurance checks at every point. Occasionally, students are unsure that the right grade has been given or are interested in seeing the grade breakdown to the questions they answered. This is where post results services may be relevant; please note these services have closing dates. **If you received a grade within 1/2 mark(s) of a grade boundary we recommend a school review is conducted but you must provide authority for this (see below):**

Step 1 Speak to exams team **on results day** about post results services, the sooner you complete a request the better

Step 2 Request Access to scripts – This provides an electronic copy of the exam paper(s) you completed in the exam with the associated awarded marks per question. **Deadlines: Year 13 – 15th August 2025 (Uni place pending) or 28th August 2025 (grade query) Year 11 – 8th September 2025 (grade query) or 30th September (for knowledge purposes)**

Step 3 Script clerical check by school or exam board – The electronic script is provided to the Head of Faculty who uses the exam board mark schemes to do a clerical check of your exam paper. This involves ensuring all parts of the exam paper have been marked, marks have been recorded/added up correctly, special consideration has been applied (if appropriate) and the grade boundaries have been applied accurately. The Head of Faculty will advise you if there is a potential case in proceeding with an exam board review of marking. If you prefer, the clerical check can also be undertaken by the exam board which is a fee service, see table below.

Step 4 Review of Marking – A check that examiners have marked externally assessed components correctly (priority service is available where a candidate's place in further/higher education depends on the outcome). This includes checking that • All pages have been marked • Addition of marks given • Result matches the marks on the paper • A review of marking of units/components by a senior examiner to identify genuine marking errors or unreasonable marking • Remark - grade can stay the same, go down as well as up. This is a fee service, see table below; however, **SPS will pay the review of marking fees for GCSE English Language & Mathematics within 1 mark of a grade four boundary if the head of faculty has confirmed a high probable case. Deadlines: Year 13 – 21st August 2025 (Uni place pending) or 28th August 2025 (grade query) Year 11 – 17th September 2025**

All deadlines quoted enable school processing time before the boards close these services.

Candidates can apply for any of the paid post results services with the exam boards for any examination component taken but these must be requested four days before board closing deadlines. Fees are relevant and must be paid before the post results service application is made.
