Individual Liberty

The ability of individuals to freely exercise rights, with responsibility.

- **Choices:** Students are encouraged to make informed choices in a safe and supportive environment at appropriate times in their school career e.g. subject options.
- The right not to tolerate bullying at school. Through our school standards and lessons students are taught about personal responsibility, choices, ambition and aspiration.
- **Empowerment:** Encourage students to know, understand and exercise their rights and personal freedoms in a responsible way e.g. through assemblies, E-Safety, PD lessons.
- Encourage participation in extra-curricular opportunities: There is a range of extracurricular clubs and activities to choose from to empower self-knowledge, self-esteem & confidence. The Duke of Edinburgh Award scheme is a foundation for students to work in the local community for good causes.
- **Charity fundraising activities:** e.g. non-uniform days, raising money for local and national charities.
- Educational choices and visits: Students are encouraged to take opportunities to follow their interests through extracurricular opportunities like art trips, Music School and Musical evening, theatre trips to London.
- Safety awareness: Students are taught to keep themselves safe, including on-line. This is done through computing lessons, assemblies, outside organisations and PD curriculum.
