## School Uniform and equipment

Uniform standards at St Peter's are good and students and staff are proud of our uniform. We are about to phase in a new uniform from September. Please find attached our uniform policy which clearly sets out our expectations. I would be grateful if you would refer to this when buying uniform over the summer holidays.

In order to reduce the confusion of what is an acceptable uniform item, we are asking parents to buy St Peter's uniform from one particular supplier. During the last year, there have been too many instances of students wearing inappropriate skirts and trousers. Consequently, this wastes parents' money when replacement items have had to be purchased. Through buying from one supplier, parents are assured that their child will be wearing what constitutes the St Peter's School uniform.

The supplier for St Peter's School Uniform is The Green School Shop, The Old Courthouse, Priory Road, Saint Ives PE27 5BB.

UNIFORM	INFORMATION AND EXPECTATIONS
Light blue Polo shirt, with St Peter's School logo	No other visible top of any sort should be seen under the polo shirt. <b>All St Peter's branded items are available from The Green School Shop in St Ives</b>
Navy blue v neck jumper with St Peter's School logo	No other top other than the Light Blue Polo should be visible under the Navy jumper. Cannot be substituted with any other top, jumper or cardigan. Optional in summer around school but should be available for assemblies
Outdoor coat	No hoodies, sports tops, track suit tops, branded jackets or coats, or branded sweatshirts. <b>If worn they will be confiscated.</b>
Trousers	Black, full length tailored trousers only. No leggings, skinny trousers or culottes. No denim of any type. No studs or embroidery on pockets. Students <b>will not</b> be allowed to wear tight fashion trousers. Appropriate black school trousers are to be purchased from the <b>Green School Shop</b>
Skirt	Must be blue pleated tartan skirt
Belts	Must not be seen, if worn must be plain black and not a fashion belt, eg with a large buckle.
Hats / Scarves	To be worn outside school buildings only, not allowed in lessons. Suitable for winter weather and not as a fashion accessory.
Make up	<b>Years 7 and 8</b> – No make-up at all. <b>Years 9, 10 and 11</b> – SUBTLE make up only. Only clear nail varnish is allowed to be worn No fake nails.
Jewellery	No bracelets, bangles, rings or necklaces. ONE small stud allowed in each ear. <b>No facial piercings of any sort, lip, face, eyebrow or tongue.</b> <b>This is strictly enforced any student found with a facial piercing will immediately be withdrawn from lessons and parents contacted.</b>
Black shoes/Black socks	No shoes with logos or coloured laces. Shoes must be black and sensible and not a health and safety risk. Plain, dark black socks Students can wear black or natural coloured tights.
Hair	No extreme haircuts, no patterns shaved into hair, one natural colour only.
School Bags	An appropriate school bag eg rucksack or holdall to transport books and equipment including pens and pencils. No fashion bags, dolly bags, clutch bags or small handbags. Any student without equipment in lessons should expect a sanction.

Royal blue polo shirt embroidered with the school logo	Compulsory – No other alternatives allowed
Royal blue shorts	Compulsory – St Peters approved brand only
Royal blue socks with turn down	Compulsory – St Peters approved brand only
Royal blue sweatshirt embroidered with the school logo	Optional – No other alternatives allowed St Peters approved brand only
