

Why is the options process important?

- First time that students get a choice over their educational pathway
- Impacts their timetabled lessons and their wider experience at school
- Helps students with their future aspirations e.g. careers, sixth form, further education and job opportunities

- They have researched and looks interesting to them


Do not select subjects because:
